Title: Identification of Non-Rodent Animals

Purpose:

To describe the procedures of individually identifying non-rodent animals.

Procedure:

- All USDA covered species will be assigned a permanent identification number upon arrival. A cage card will be placed on the exterior of the cage which will indicate this number and additional information according to SOP "Preparation and Use of Cage Cards."
- Animals may arrive with a permanent identification code already present. This code may be used as the individual identification number. If such a code is not present, then all non-rodent animals will be identified with ear tags, tattoos, or subcutaneous microchip implants.
